<u>Title:</u> Tissue Papered Vase

Subject Area: Art

Grade Level: 5th Grade

Materials:

glass bottle (Snapple or Arizona iced tea) paintbrushes glue Tupperware containers tissue paper

NYS Standards:

- 1. Students will be able to create a tissue papered vase using a glass bottle and glue.
- 2. Students will be able to utilize and manipulate tissue paper and glue.
- 3. Students will be able to recognize art vocabulary terms such as functional art.
- 4. Students will be able to recognize and appreciate functional art and its influence in the world.

Motivation:

Begin by asking students what they think art is. Ask students to look made up table (has tablecloth, dishes, vase, mugs, etc) and ask if they think there is art on the table. Explain that there is fine art that we view and appreciate and functional art that we appreciate as well as serves a purpose. Use the items on the made up table as examples of functional art.

Procedure:

- 1. Explain motivation and project to students.
- 2. Have students pick out 3 different colors of tissue paper.
- 3. Hand out bottles, glue mixtures and paintbrushes to each table.
- 4. Demonstrate how to tear and apply the tissue paper to the bottle.
- 5. Have students tear and apply tissue paper to their bottle.

- 6. Once finished, wait until project is dry and have students put a layer of just the glue mixture over the surface.
- 7. When project is completed, have class critique
